

Digital Fights at AYPT 2020 - Overview

The fights at a digital AYPT are in some important ways different to the fights at a regular AYPT:

- Fights are only between **two teams**
- There is only a **Reporter** and an **Opponent** but no **Reviewer**
- Fights therefore only have **two stages**
- The **Report** is **not a live presentation** but submitted as a **pre-recorded Youtube video** some days before the competition (every team has to submit video reports for 3 problems)

Digital Fights at AYPT 2020 - Schedule (1/2)

- The virtual Fightroom (Zoom Meetingroom) can be joined 15 minutes before the start of the fight. The chair of the fight will be present.

When joining the virtual Fightroom choose an appropriate name:

- “Teamname: Firstname Lastname” if you are a Teammember
 - “Juror: Firstname Lastname” if you are a Juror
 - “Chair: Firstname Lastname” if you are chair
 - “Observer (Teamname): Firstname Lastname” if you are none of the above and associated with a team
 - “Observer: Firstname Lastname” if you are none of the above and not associated with a team
- The fight starts with a short introduction of Teams and Judges moderated by the chair (5-10 minutes)

Digital Fights at AYPT 2020 - Schedule (2/2)

- The first stage of the fight starts
 - The opposing Team challenges one of the remaining problems of the reporting team
 - A link to the Youtube of the report is posted into the chat of the Zoom Room
 - Preparation time for the Opposition (30 minutes)
 - Opponent takes the floor (4 minutes)
 - Discussion between Reporter and Opponent (10 minutes)
 - Closing Remarks of the Opponent (1 minute)
 - Closing Remarks of the Reporter (2 minutes)
 - Jury Questions (5 minutes)
 - Jury fills out the grading sheets (5 minutes)
 - Jury gives the scores and feedback (5 minutes)
- Break (10 minutes)
- The second stage of the fight starts
 - Apart from the restriction that the opposing team must not challenge the problem it has presented in the first stage (if possible) the second stage is identical to the first.
- Chair closes the fight

Digital Fights at AYPT 2020 - Remarks

- If possible the opponent in the second stage **must not challenge the same problem presented in the first stage**
- There is only **one Team Member** speaking for the Opposition and the Reporting Team
- The opposition team is encouraged **to use a private meeting room** for the 30 minutes preparation phase
- You can **share your screen**, as well as use a **whiteboard** in Zoom to facilitate the discussion and support you in your presentation
